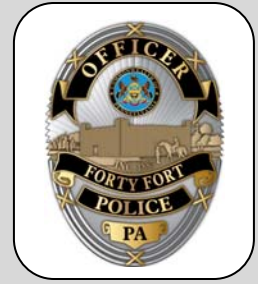

June 17, 2015

On June 17, 2015, from 7:45 AM until 9:15 AM, Officer William Stone and I conducted a speed survey on Murray Street at the intersection of Yeager Avenue. This speed survey was the result of complaints filed by residents of Yeager Avenue about vehicles speeding on Murray Street.

The speed survey was conducted by utilizing an ENRAD Speed Monitoring device.

The results of this speed survey are as follows:

95 Cars were targeted while traveling in both the North bound and South bound lanes on Murray Street.

The Speed Limit on Murray Street is 25 MPH. Municipal Police must allow for 10 MPH over posted speed limit. This means that in order for there to be a violation, vehicles need to be traveling at a minimum, 11 MPH over the posted speed limit, or in the case of Murray Street, 36 MPH.

The average speed of vehicles targeted was 26.28 MPH. 2 of the 95 vehicles were found to be slightly in violation of the posted speed limit.

The following depicts the speed and how many vehicles traveled that speed during this survey:
