

FORTY FORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION NO. 3 OF 2014

WHEREAS, Forty Fort Borough Council is aware of that the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation will be temporarily re-timing the traffic signals at Wyoming Avenue and Dennison Street as part of a roadway construction project; and

WHEREAS, Forty Fort Borough Council is also aware that, as part of the aforesaid roadway construction project, the Department of Transportation will be able to obtain more current vehicle counts of traffic proceeding through the signals controlled intersection; and

WHEREAS, Forty Fort Borough Council deems it to be in the best interests of the Borough and its residents to utilize the data obtained by the Department of Transportation in order to thereafter provide new timing for the traffic control signals; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the benefits of the re-timing of the traffic control signals, it is necessary for Forty Fort Borough to execute and submit to the Department of Transportation an "Application for Traffic Signal Approval" in the form prepared by the said Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of Forty Fort Borough as follows:


1. That Jeffrey McLaughlin, President of Forty Fort Borough Council, is authorized and directed to sign the Application for Traffic Signal Approval.

2. That Barbara Fairchild, Borough Secretary is authorized and directed to attest the execution of the said Application for Traffic Signal Approval and to thereafter submit a certified copy of the same to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation on behalf of Forty Fort Borough (the "MUNICIPALITY" referred to in the said Application).
