

RESOLUTION

No. 6 of 2014

A Resolution to amend information for the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Single Application for Local Share Account (Luzerne County) Funds for funding to upgrade and improve the conditions of the Forty Fort Police Department and Borough Building energy efficiency and renovations in the amount of \$103,917.00 which was submitted to the DCED in December of 2013.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Forty Fort recognizes that the health, safety and security of its residents, police officers and employees are paramount; and

WHEREAS, the current offices of the Police Department are not conducive to the implementation of police work and does not provide the appropriate measures necessary for the security, safety and welfare of the officers and citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Forty Fort Borough Building is highly energy inefficient and in dire need of improvements and renovations to accommodate the needs of current society; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Forty Fort requests DCED to approve the Borough of Forty Fort's request for gaming funds to be used for upgrades and improvements to the Forty Fort Police Department offices and to improve the energy efficiency and to make improvements and renovations to the Borough Building.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Forty Fort authorizes Jeff McLaughlin BARBARA Fairchild as it's designee to execute documents pertaining to Borough of Forty Fort's DCED single application for request for gaming funds for upgrades and improvements of Forty Fort Police Department and Borough Building energy efficiency and renovations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Forty Fort officially supports the Single Application to be filed by the Borough of Forty Fort seeking gaming funds to be used for upgrades and improvements to the Forty Fort Police Department offices and to improve the energy efficiency and to make improvements and renovations to the Borough Building.
