

**FORTY FORT BOROUGH COUNCIL**

**RESOLUTION NO.** 7 of 2014

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of Forty Fort Borough has advised Forty Fort Borough Council that, in the Mayor's opinion, authorizing him to delegate certain of his powers to the Borough Manager will enhance the effective and timely functioning of the Borough's administrative offices; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania provides, in Section 1007-A (2), that except as provided in section 1006 (4) relating to powers of Borough Council, it shall be the duty of the Mayor "to sign papers, contracts, obligations and documents as may be required by law"; and

**WHEREAS**, the said Borough Code also provides, in Section 1142, that "With approval of borough council, the mayor may delegate to the borough manager any of the mayor's nonlegislative and nonjudicial powers and duties."; and

**WHEREAS**, the said Borough Code further provides, in Section 1006 (4), that Borough Council shall have the duty to "enact, revise, repeal and amend ... resolutions ... as it deems beneficial to the borough ..."; and

**WHEREAS**, Forty Fort Borough Council deems it to be in the best interests of the Borough and the effective and timely functioning of its administrative offices to approve the Mayor's request to be permitted to delegate his powers "to sign papers, contracts, obligations and documents as may be required by law" to the Borough Manager.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of Forty Fort Borough as follows:

1. That the Mayor of Forty Fort Borough be and hereby is authorized to delegate his powers "to sign papers, contracts, obligations and documents as may be required by law" to the Borough Manager.


2. That the Mayor of Forty Fort Borough, by means of the execution of his "Delegation", attached hereto and made a part hereof, does hereby delegate his aforesaid powers to the Borough Manager.

3. Nothing herein shall be construed as denying to the Mayor the power to personally sign any paper, contract, obligation or document should he personally be present and able to sign the same; it being the intent and purpose of his delegation of


power to avoid the delay that would necessarily result from the need to await his arrival at the Borough administrative offices to perform such duty.

4. That all such lawful papers, contracts, obligations and documents signed by the Borough Manager pursuant to the delegation by the Mayor of such authority shall be deemed to have been properly executed official acts of the Borough of Forty Fort as if the same had been personally signed by the Mayor.
