GLASS, CANS, AND PLASTIC (COMINGLED)

Must be placed in a Forty Fort Borough recycling container. Recyclable items in any other type of container will be refused for pick up.
RESIDENTS MAY DROP OFF THEIR SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING AT THE BOROUGH GARAGE FROM 7 AM TO 2:30 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY IN DESIGNATED DUMPSTER.

Additional Forty Fort Borough recycling containers can be purchased at the Forty Fort Borough Building, 1271 Wyoming Avenue, Forty Fort, PA 18704
Acceptable items are: #1 through #7 plastics • Aluminum Cans • Tin/Steel Cans (rinsed) • Glass Bottles

Acceptable Plastics #1 through #7:

- #1 – Plastic soda and water bottles and similar
- #2 – Laundry, fabric softener, shampoo and conditioner and similar containers
- #3 – Cooking oil bottles, baby bottle nipples, shrink wrap and similar
- #4 – Grocery and sandwich bags
- #5 – Syrup bottles, yogurt tubs
- #6 – Coffee cups and disposable cutlery and cups
- #7 – Products labeled as “other”

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE:
No Mirrors • No Toys or Small Toys
No Window Panes, Flat Glass or Aquarium Glass
No Appliances, etc.

All recyclables must be placed curbside in a Blue Recyclable container provided by Forty Fort Borough.
Every resident is entitled to one (1) bin with additional bins available at the Municipal Building at a cost of \$10.00 each.

NEWSPAPERS/NEWSPRINT/MAGAZINES/JUNK MAIL/OFFICE PAPER

Place in brown paper/plastic grocery bag or bundle and tie securely with sturdy cotton string. No tape or wire.
Loose paper of any kind placed in a recycling bin or any other type of container will be refused.

CARDBOARD

Corrugated Cardboard shipping boxes (including pizza boxes) must be flattened, bundled and tied securely with sturdy cotton string or rope.

If it is not flattened and tied it will not be picked up.

Soda, cereal, frozen food, and shoe/gift boxes etc. must be flattened and placed in brown paper bag or tied securely with sturdy cotton string.

Loose cardboard of any kind placed in a recycling bin or any other type of container will be refused.

No boxes containing food of any kind will be taken. This belongs in your garbage.

YARD WASTE

Garden wastes, grass clippings, tree trimmings, chipped shrubbery and other vegetative materials will be collected.

Use biodegradable paper leaf bags or Forty Fort recycling container for small trimmings. No other type of container will be accepted.

Bundle and tie tree/shrubbery branches (no longer than 4 feet long) with sturdy cotton string or rope.

YARD WASTE WILL BE PICKED UP EVERY WEDNESDAY FROM APRIL 4, 2018 TO OCTOBER 31, 2018.

LEAVES

Place in biodegradable paper leaf bags. No other containers will be accepted.

Leaves will be picked up every day from October 29, 2018 to December 7, 2018, weather permitting.

DO NOT RAKE OR BLOW LEAVES INTO THE STREET

CODE ENFORCEMENT/ZONING

SHADE TREE COMMISSION

All trees on the tree lawn fall under the jurisdiction of the Shade Tree Commission. Prior to pruning or removing a tree located on the tree lawn, permission must be received from the Shade Tree Commission. A fine can be imposed if permission is not received prior to pruning or removing of the tree.

A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for pruning and \$25.00 for removal of any trees. Applications may be found on the borough's website Fortyfort.org or at the Borough Building. If you have any questions, please contact Tom Craig at 570-287-8586 ext. 29.

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT (Garbage Collection)

Forty Fort Borough does not provide garbage collection. Residents need to contract with an independent hauler for garbage removal.

While we do not recommend any particular company, we are providing the names of some haulers that currently pick up:

MEDICAL WASTE

Residents may not place any type of medical waste in the recycle containers. Please contact your physician, pharmacist or hospital for safe options of disposal. Further information may also be obtained by calling the DEP Regional Office at 570-826-2511.

PARKING PERMITS

Any vehicle parked on a borough street during the hours of 2AM - 5AM must have a current year parking permit displayed in the rear window of the vehicle to avoid receiving a \$15.00 parking ticket. Current year parking stickers are available at the Forty Fort Borough Building during normal business hours or by visiting Fortyfort.org to purchase with your debit/credit card. Overnight parking permits can also be purchased this way for any vehicle that needs to be on the street during these hours temporarily. The cost is \$2.00 per vehicle, per night.
