WE NOW RECYCLE ON MONDAYS AND TUESDAYS!!!

GLASS, CANS, AND PLASTIC (COMINGLED)

Must be placed in a Forty Fort Borough recycling container. Recyclable items in any other type of container will be refused for pick up.
RESIDENTS MAY DROP OFF THEIR SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING AT THE BOROUGH GARAGE FROM 7 AM TO 2:30 PM, MONDAY AND TUESDAY IN DESIGNATED DUMPSTER.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED: THESE ITEMS MUST BE IN A BOROUGH ISSUED RECYCLING BUCKET

PET Plastic containers with the symbol #1
HDPE natural plastic containers with the symbol #2 (milk & water bottles)
HDPE pigmented plastic containers with the symbol #2
(detergent, shampoo bottles, etc)
Aluminum food & beverage containers – cleaned of any food or drink
Tin (steel) cans
Glass bottles

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED: THESE ITEMS BELONG IN YOUR TRASH

Plastic Bags
Coat/Clothing hangars
Microwave trays
Light bulbs
Porcelain
Glass Cookware/Bakeware
Animal Waste
Household items such as pots, toasters, microwaves, etc.
Tissues, paper towels/other paper products that have been in contact with food
ANY ALLOWABLE RECYCLABLE ITEM THAT IS NOT CLEAN!

Batteries
Scrap Metal
Mirrors or Auto Glass
Ceramics
Plastics without a number
Spittoons

All recyclables must be placed curbside in a Blue Recyclable container provided by Forty Fort Borough.
Every resident is entitled to one (1) bin with additional bins available at the Municipal Building at a cost of \$15.00 each.

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES/JUNK MAIL/OFFICE PAPER

These items should be placed in a PAPER BAG or bundled and placed in your recycle container. They include newspapers, magazines, catalogs, cereal boxes, telephone books, printer paper, copier paper and mail.

CARDBOARD

Corrugated Cardboard shipping boxes (including pizza boxes) must be flattened, bundled and tied securely with sturdy cotton string or rope.

If it is not flattened and tied it will not be picked up.

Soda, cereal, frozen food, and shoe/gift boxes etc. must be flattened and placed in brown paper bag or tied securely with sturdy cotton string.

Loose cardboard of any kind placed in a recycling bin or any other type of container will be refused.

No boxes containing food of any kind will be taken. This belongs in your garbage.

YARD WASTE WILL NOW BE COLLECTED ON YOUR DESIGNATED RECYCLE DAY:

Garden wastes, grass clippings, tree trimmings, chipped shrubbery and other vegetative materials will be collected.

Use biodegradable paper leaf bags or Forty Fort recycling container for small trimmings. No other type of container will be accepted.

Bundle and tie tree/shrubbery branches (no longer than 4 feet long) with sturdy cotton string or rope.

Yard Waste will be picked up every Monday from April 4, 2022 through October 31, 2022

LEAVES

Place in biodegradable paper leaf bags. No other containers will be accepted.

LEAVES WILL BE PICKED UP EVERY DAY FROM NOVEMBER 7, 2022 THROUGH DECEMBER 5, 2022, (Weather Permitting.)

DO NOT RAKE OR BLOW LEAVES INTO THE STREET

CODE ENFORCEMENT/ZONING

SHADE TREE COMMISSION

All trees on the tree lawn fall under the jurisdiction of the Shade Tree Commission. Pruning permits are \$10.00 per tree; removal permits are \$25.00 plus \$150.00 re-planting deposit per tree and must be obtained before the work is done. A fine can be imposed if permission is not received. Applications can be found on the Borough's web site, Fortyfort.org or at the Borough Building. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT:

FORTY FORT BOROUGH NOW GARBAGE!

Residents may purchase a window sticker for \$300.00 per year. There will be a 10% discount for residents over the age of 65 or a 5% discount for past or present military (proof will be required on both). Residents will be provided with a 65-gallon garbage can where they can place up to four (4) 13-gallon trash bags. ALL GARBAGE MUST BE CONTAINED INSIDE GARBAGE BAGS! Extra bag stickers will be available for \$3.00 each. Bulk item pick-up will also be available for \$10.00. Mattress and Box Spring pick-up will be \$30.00 each. Stickers must be purchased at the office of the Secretary.

MEDICAL WASTE

Residents may not place any type of medical waste in the recycle containers. Please contact your physician, pharmacist or hospital for safe options of disposal. Further information may also be obtained by calling the DEP Regional Office at 570-826-2511.

Un-needed prescriptions can be safely disposed of in the receptacle at the Forty Fort Borough Building.

PARKING PERMITS

Any vehicle parked on a borough street during the hours of 2AM – 5AM must have a current parking permit displayed in their vehicle to avoid receiving a \$15.00 ticket. We are now selling a rear-view mirror hangar in place of the sticker that went into the rear window. You may now purchase an extra hangar to have in the event of unexpected overnight guests who need to park on the street. All permits are \$25.00 each.
