Thank you for the response and understanding. I do believe that waiting until the June 1st meeting may ultimately be more beneficial for everyone involved. That additional time would allow us to coordinate internally and ensure we have the appropriate personnel available to answer questions and concerns.

As mentioned previously, the role of the 911 Center is advisory in nature from a public safety perspective. We can identify concerns and make recommendations to municipalities regarding duplicate street names or addressing issues, but ultimately any decisions regarding changes remain with the municipality itself. Over the years, we have approached municipalities as concerns are identified or brought to our attention. Some municipalities have elected to make significant addressing changes on their own, while others have chosen more limited changes or elected not to proceed.

I certainly understand the concerns being raised by both residents and council regarding the burden associated with address changes and related documentation updates. I believe taking the additional time to prepare will allow for a more productive discussion where we can better explain the reasoning behind these recommendations, the public safety concerns involved, and the general process followed when these issues are identified.

Thank you again, and please let me know if June 1st would work for the Borough.
