

## FORTY FORT, PA

August 17, 2009  
Continuation of the August 3, 2009  
Regular Meeting of Council

The regular meeting of Forty Fort Borough Council held on Monday, August 3, 2009 was continued on Monday, August 17, 2009 at the Forty Fort Borough Building, 1271 Wyoming Avenue, Forty Fort, with President Joseph Chacke presiding.

Council Members present were as follows: Deanna Brown, Robert Craig, Charles Kamus, Betty Mascelli, Frank Michaels, Dave Williams, Dick Yingst and President Joseph Chacke. James McCabe was absent.

Also present was Borough Secretary/Coordinator Denise Syms.

President Chacke called the meeting to order at 7:25 p.m.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Pool House Accessibility Project. Borton-Lawson Engineering reviewed the bids and recommends the low bidder of Ruckno.

Motion by Mr. Yingst to accept Ruckno's base bid and alternate #1 for the railing. Second by Mr. Craig.

On the question, alternate #1 changes the steel railing to aluminum which requires less maintenance. Some costs will need to be paid out of the general fund, but the bulk of the cost will come from a grant.

Motion passed without dissent.

Mr. Coutts submitted an addition bill for work that was done on Friday before WWSA unblocked the main in front of the Stella Presbyterian Church.

Motion by Mr. Yingst to pay the bill of \$155 to Stella Presbyterian Church with the stipulation to submit the bill to WWSA. Second by Ms. Mascelli.

Motion passed without dissent.

Motion by Mr. Craig to increase the crossing guard hourly rate from \$8.25 to \$9.00. Second by Ms. Mascelli.

On the question, President Chacke explained that the Mayor made the request, the impact on the budget and the school district's reimbursement of 60%.

Motion passed without dissent.

Motion by Mr. Craig to hire John Bevilaqua as a part-time police officer contingent upon passing the necessary tests. Second by Mr. Yingst.

On the question, Mr. Michaels asked if he is Act 120 certified. President Chacke stated yes. Mr. Yingst stated that he is physically fit. Members of Council reviewed his application.

Motion passed without dissent.

ADJOURNMENT:

Motion by Mr. Craig and seconded by Ms. Brown to adjourn.  
Motion carried without dissent.

The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
