Work Session

Forty Fort Borough Council held a work session on Monday, February 16, 2009 at the Forty Fort Borough Building ,
1271 Wyoming Avenue
, Forty Fort, with President Joseph Chacke presiding.

Council Members present were as follows: Deanna Brown, Robert Craig, Charles Kamus, Betty Mascelli, James McCabe, Frank Michaels, Dave Williams, Richard Yingst and President Joseph Chacke.

Also present were Mayor Boyd Hoats Jr., and Borough Secretary/Coordinator Denise Syms. There were six (6) visitors.

President Chacke called the work session to order at 7:30 p.m.

Bruce Cottle,
59 Butler Street
, on behalf of the Forty Fort United Methodist Church addressed Council regarding a tree on the treelawn. Mr. Cottle was told that the Church would need to submit an application to the Shade Tree Commission for the removal of the trees.

Carol Seltzer stated that the Shade Tree Commission submitted a grant application for trees and that a pruning clinic will be held on April 4th at 9 a.m. at Marywood College .

Dave Yefko from Borton-Lawson Engineering discussed the
Welles Street
project and the new parking proposal.

Mrs. Mascelli discussed the Abrahams Creek inspection by DEP and that 25 trees need to come down.

Mr. Kamus discussed the Fire Co. sign on the Borough property and that it needs to be removed.

Mrs. Brown stated that the Dunkin Donuts drive-thru volume is turned up again.

Mr. Michaels discussed the potholes in the alley on the east side of
Murray Street
between Crisman and Durkee and when the potholes will be cold patched.

President Chacke stated that a garbage/solid waste ordinance will be up for adoption at the next Council Meeting. President Chacke also discussed the levy fee, taxes, and gaming fund grants. President Chacke explained an ordinance restricting parking on

Wyoming Avenue

to accommodate Forty Fort Lube's new location.
