The February work session of the Forty Fort Borough Council was held on Monday, Feb. 17, 2014 at the Forty Fort Borough Bldg., 1271 Wyoming Ave., Forty Fort, with President, Jeff McLaughlin presiding.

Also present were Mayor Andy Tuzinski, Manager, Barbara Fairchild & Secretary, Bonnie Arnone.

Topics discussed were as follows:

- The Borough current snow emergency ordinances and changes that may need to be made to same.
- Topping & pruning of trees on borough tree lawns.
- Possible change to borough ordinance dealing with cost sharing for those property owners who have been given permission by the Shade Tree Commission to remove their tree. Currently, it states "up to \$250.00" cost share. Since there is a minimal amount of money budgeted for that line item, lowering the amount to "up to \$100.00", would allow the borough to assist more property owners with this cost sharing.
- Families for Forty Fort Park will hold their Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, April 12, 2014 at the Forty Fort Park. A basket raffle will be held and all donations will be greatly appreciated.
- Engraved bricks will also be sold by Families for Forty Fort Park.
