President Chacke called the work session to order at approximately 9:10 p.m.


Some of the issues discussed were:

- It was suggested to review all employee job descriptions
- It was suggested to review the recycling program to enhance revenue
- The Shade Tree Ordinance requiring homeowners notice prior to planting was discussed
- The Shade Tree application and the amount of time the Commission has to respond and the establishment of a time limit was discussed
- Shade Tree Commission meetings and advertising them was discussed
- It was noted that the weapons purchased with the grant obtained from the District Attorney's office in collaboration with Wyoming Borough have been purchased and are expected to be received soon
- The option to lease a police vehicle(s) instead of purchasing as approved in the budget was discussed
- The Pennsylvania Attorney General grant opportunity to purchase breathalyzer's was discussed
- The dispensation of the EMA Blazer was discussed
- The impressive performance by the Police Chief was discussed
