COUNCIL WORK SESSION

JANAURY 21, 2014

The January work session of the Forty Fort Borough Council was held on Tuesday, January 21, 2014 at the Forty Fort Borough Bldg., 1271 Wyoming Ave., Forty Fort, with President Jeff McLaughlin present.

President McLaughlin called the meeting to order at 8:22 PM immediately following the special meeting of council with the following members of council present: Dorothy Craig, Robert Craig, Frank Michaels, Deborah Troy & Karen Martinelli via telephone. Charles Rick Kamus was absent.

Also present were Mayor Andy Tuzinski, Manager Barbara Fairchild, Secretary Bonnie Arnone, and Mark Voyack, Rich Kresge & Carl Schimmel of Quad 3 Group.

- Representatives from Quad 3 Group were present to explain the progress thus far with the Sewer Rehabilitation Project, which is slated to begin on Monday, February 3, 2014, and also the street paving project.
- The compost project is still un resolved due to issue with getting water to the site.
- It was suggested that in the future, any openings on Commissions or Boards be advertised to allow everyone a change to apply for the position.
- Balloons by Justin were never paid for services at the 125th Celebration. He will re submit a bill.
- Safety issues concerning the Boulevard Lights on River St. were discussed.
- The failure to return keys & radios from Joseph Chacke was discussed. Atty. Haley will send a letter to request the return of these items.
- Melissa Tomascik will be asked to become more active in the Shade Tree Commission.
- Representatives from NY Life Insurance would like to offer employees a retirement option which would be voluntary. They require at least five people to be part of the plan.
- Personal cell phone use for Borough business was discussed for Barbara Fairchild. Council would like to discuss a reimbursement to her for such use. She was also asked if she had taken a percentage of any grants she had garnered for the borough as per her contract.
