## Work Session

Forty Fort Borough Council held a work session on Monday, June 15, 2009 at the Forty Fort Borough Building, 1271 Wyoming Avenue, Forty Fort, with President Joseph Chacke presiding.

Council Members present were as follows: Deanna Brown, Robert Craig, Charles Kamus, Betty Mascelli, Frank Michaels, Dave Williams, Richard Yingst and President Joseph Chacke. James McCabe was absent.

Also present was Borough Secretary/Coordinator Denise Syms. There were four (4) visitors.

President Chacke called the work session to order at 7:45 p.m.

The following issues were discussed:

- The storm water from Wesley Street flooded Mrs. Brown's basement and the run-off from Dunkin Donuts flooded her yard.
- Apartment house off of River Street repaved their lot and flooded Dr. Sgarlat and Andy Tuzinski's houses in the back. Mr. Tuzinski asked Mr. Nowroski if he could raise his property.
- 25 Bedford Street has a low spot in front of the house. The drain was paved over and when it rains it floods the basement and garage.
- Health insurance increases.
- At the end of Tripp Street, the alley residents want us to put barriers up. Cars are going over the tracks.
- The thru-traffic in the alleys behind Dunkin Donuts and between Shoemaker to Yates.
- Earth Conservancy donation
- House located on the corner of Hughes Street.
- July 1<sup>st</sup>, the borough cannot sell contractor licenses.
- Hiring of part-time police officers.
- Bond issue/loan options.
- Length of Council meetings, including procedural issues.
