Continuation of the June 2, 2009Regular Meeting of Council

The regular meeting of Forty Fort Borough Council held on Tuesday, June 2, 2009 was continued on Monday, June 15, 2009 at the Forty Fort Borough Building, 1271 Wyoming Avenue, Forty Fort, with President Joseph Chacke presiding.

Council Members present were as follows: Deanna Brown, Robert Craig, Charles Kamus, Betty Mascelli, Dave Williams, Dick Yingst and President Joseph Chacke. Frank Michaels arrived at 7:30 p.m. and James McCabe was absent.

Also present was Borough Secretary/Coordinator Denise Syms.

President Chacke called the meeting to order at 7:25 p.m.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Motion by Mr. Craig to overturn the decision of the Shade Tree Commission and grant the homeowner of 1110 Wyoming Avenue permission to remove the tree.

On the question, Mr. Williams asked which tree is it, the one on the avenue or the one on Tripp Street. President Chacke stated the one on Tripp Street.

Mr. Craig amended his motion to grant the homeowner permission to remove the tree on Tripp Street located nearest the avenue pursuant to the Shade Tree ordinance.

Motion passed without dissent.

Motion by Mr. Yingst to enter into an agreement with Borton-Lawson to do the engineering work for the ADA compliance at the pool in the amount of \$16,406. Second by Mrs. Brown.

President Chacke explained that the engineering expense is not included and that it is a shovel ready fast track grant and the project is \$125,000.

Mr. Craig asked if we have the money. President Chacke explained that we do.

Mr. Craig asked if we can use the money for anything else at the pool. President Chacke explained that it is written for ADA compliance and other items will be repaired to comply.

Motion passed without dissent.

Motion by Mrs. Mascelli to appoint Joe Chacke to be the Forty Fort representative on the tax committee. Second by Mr. Yingst.

On the question, Mr. Yingst asked if he can be it. President Chacke explained that it is not for tax collector. It is a committee to appoint a county wide tax collector.

Motion passed without dissent.

Motion by Mr. Michaels to have specs drawn up for streets to be paved and bids to be advertised for council's consideration. Second by Mr. Craig.

Motion passed without dissent.

President Chacke recognized Lauren Brown for serving as Junior Councilperson for the 2008/2009 term.

ADJOURNMENT:

Motion by Mr. Craig and seconded by Mr. Williams to adjourn.

Motion carried without dissent.

The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
