

FORTY FORT BOROUGH  
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
MONDAY, MARCH 17, 2025

The Forty Fort Borough council held a Special Council meeting for general purposes on Monday, March 17, 2025 at the Borough Bldg., 1271 Wyoming Ave., with council president, Thomas J. Murray, III, presiding.

COUNCIL ACTION ITEMS:

Motion by Ms. Devine to adopt Ordinance 2 of 2025 – The Amended Dog Ordinance specifically known as the “Unlawful to allow dogs to run at large” ordinance. Second by Ms. Michaels. All council was in favor of this motion. Motion passed.

Motion by Ms. Devine to advertise a Request for Proposal for a consultant on the STMP Grant which was obtained for a new DPW facility. Second by Mr. Sieminski. All council was in favor of this motion. Motion passed.

Motion by Ms. Dadurka to make a \$200.00 to the Kingston/Forty Fort Baseball & Softball organization for the 2025 Forty Fort Borough signs at the fields. Second by Ms. Gallagher. All council was in favor of this motion. Motion passed.

Motion by Mr. Sieminski to advertise Ordinance 3 of 2025 – Shade Tree Ordinance for a vote at the April 7, 2025 council meeting. Second by Ms. Devine. All council was in favor of this motion. Motion passed.

President Murray stated that following the adjournment of the special meeting, the council committee for fire & police would be meeting with members of the volunteer fire company.
