







HOMETOWN HEROES 2023 BANNER APPLICATION

Sponsored by the Forty Fort Lions

Please complete this application form to order a banner for a Forty Fort military service veteran, past or present. (Applications from communities bordering or neighboring Forty Fort are acceptable as well.)

Applications must be received by Friday, March 1, 2024.

The banner is constructed of a heavy-duty vinyl, and is 30" wide (2.5 ft.) by 60" tall (5 ft.). The initial cost per banner is \$225.00 for the production, installation, removal, and storage of the banner.

The banner will be displayed for a three-year period at which time it will be evaluated for wear and tear. Neither the Forty Fort Lions nor Forty Fort Borough will be responsible for any environmental damage to the banner. A damaged banner will be considered the responsibility of the family and will be returned to the family. Arrangements will be made to reorder damaged banners.

Banners are expected to be erected in May, around Memorial Day, and taken down in November, around Veteran's Day. Exact dates at which the banners will be erected and taken down are not guaranteed. Placement location of a banner is also not guaranteed. All banners will be placed in storage in a Forty Fort borough facility for the winter months.

The photo for the banner should preferably be the honoree's service picture of him or her in uniform. Original photos work best. Copies or cell phone pictures of an original are not recommended. No group photos will be accepted. It is understood that the Forty Fort Lions are granted permission to use the attached photo for the Forty Fort Hometown Heroes program.
